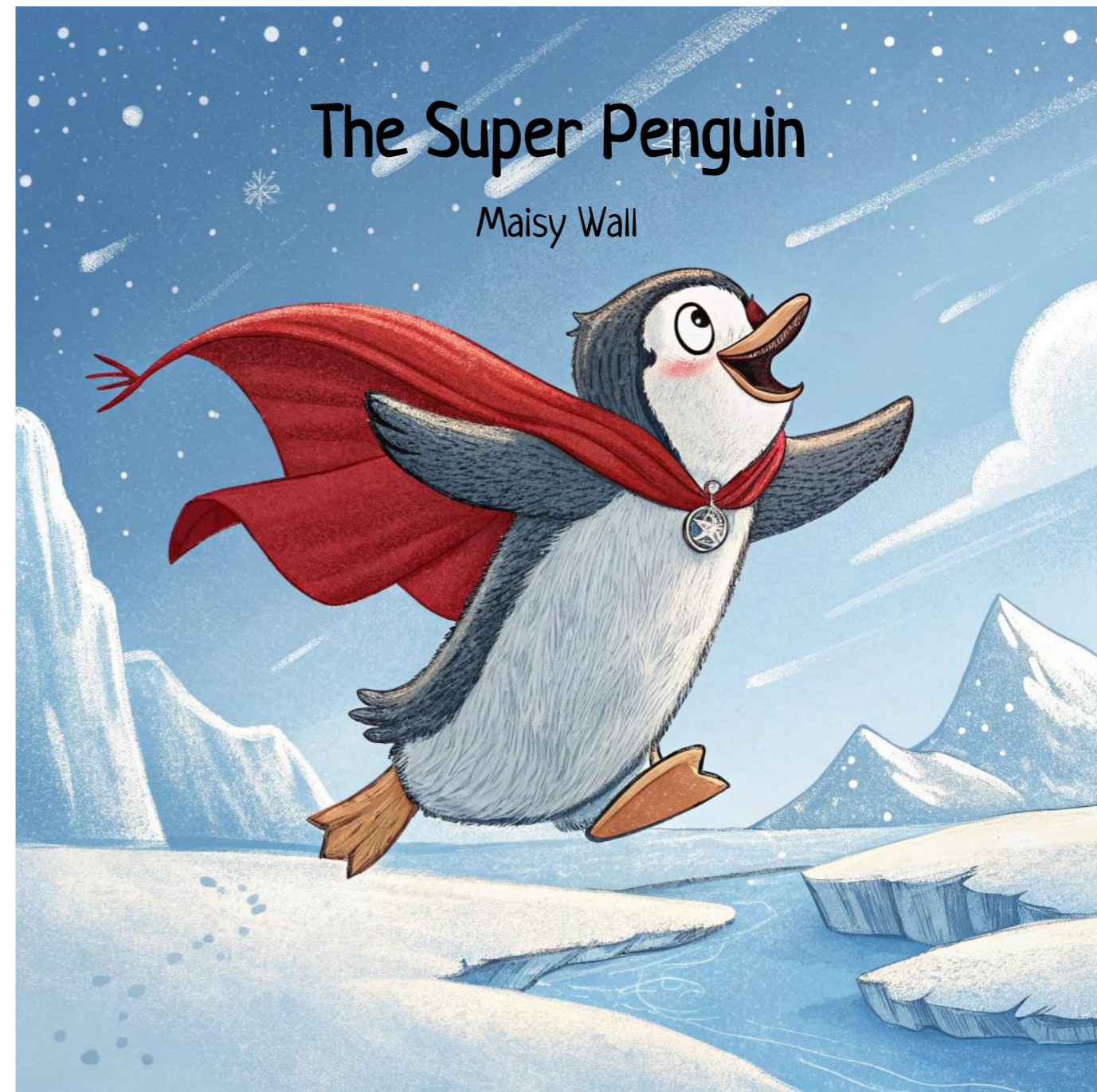

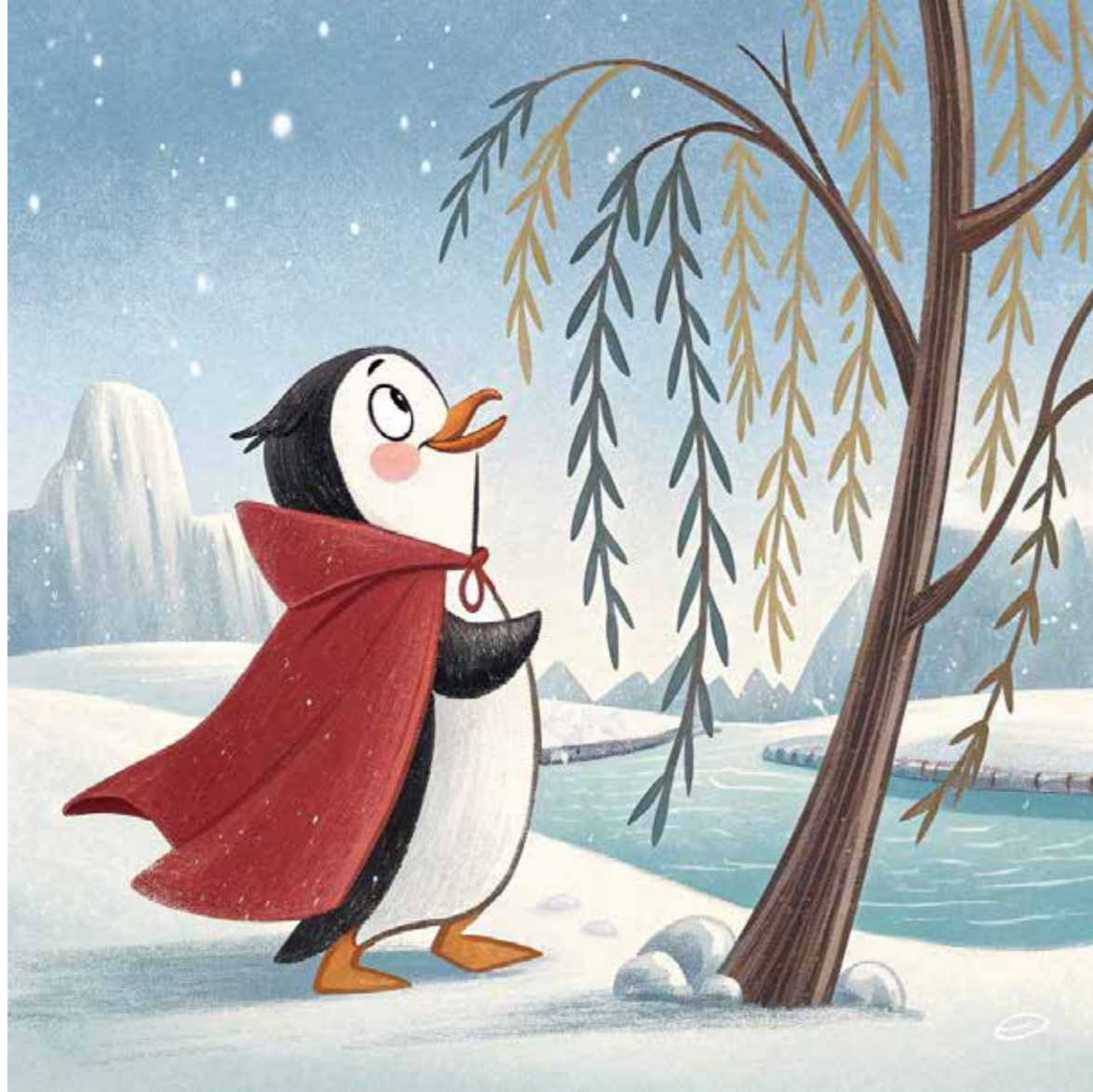

But she was so busy looking at some cute polar bear cubs playing that she accidentally crashed into another tree. OOPS!

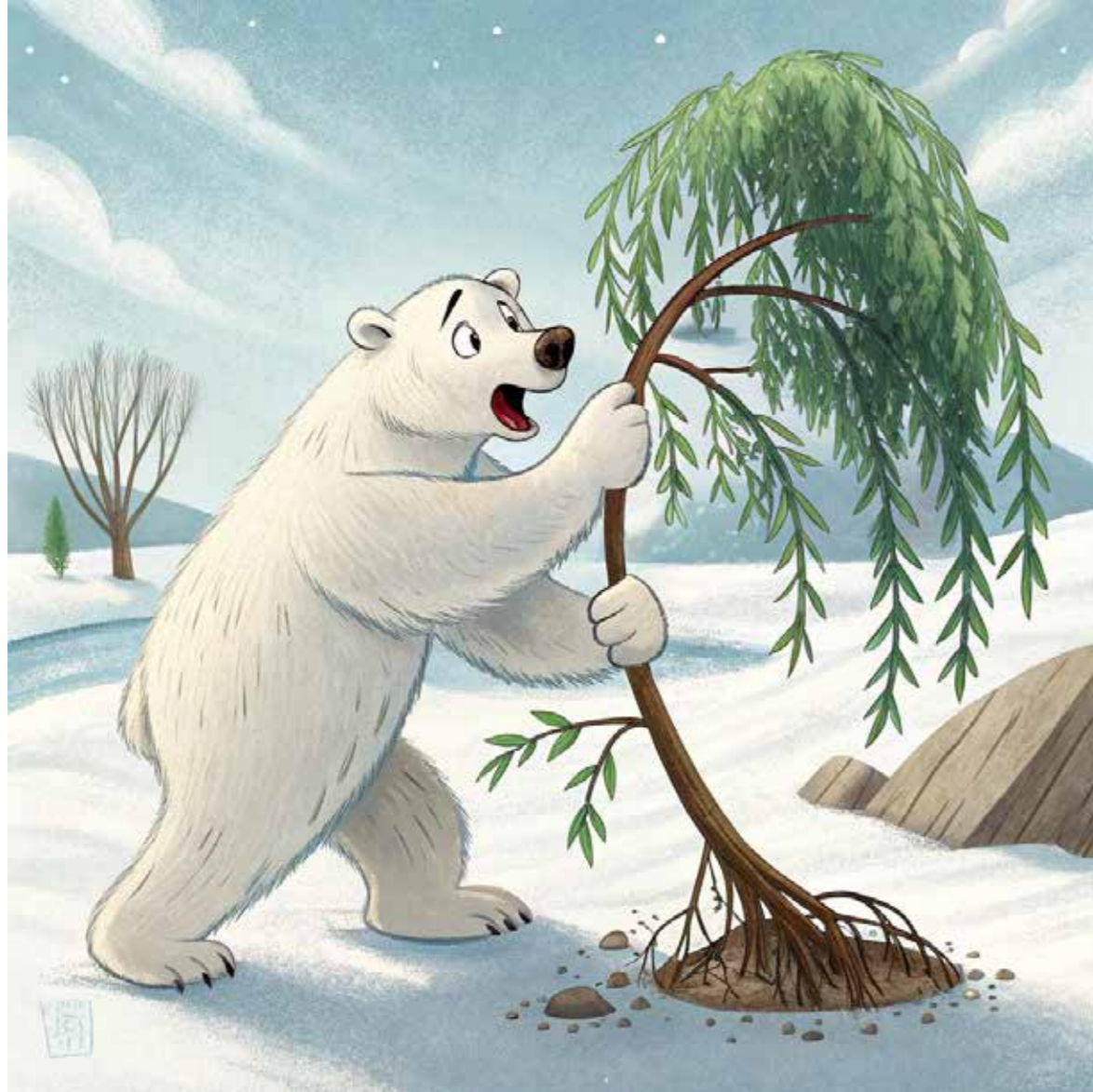
She fell down to the soft, snowy ground and her head got buried in the snow. She could not get out! She shouted 'HELP! I'M STUCK!'.

But Bella was too strong and she lifted it out too quick and it bumped Peggy on the head. "Ouch, my head" said Peggy "I'm so unlucky".

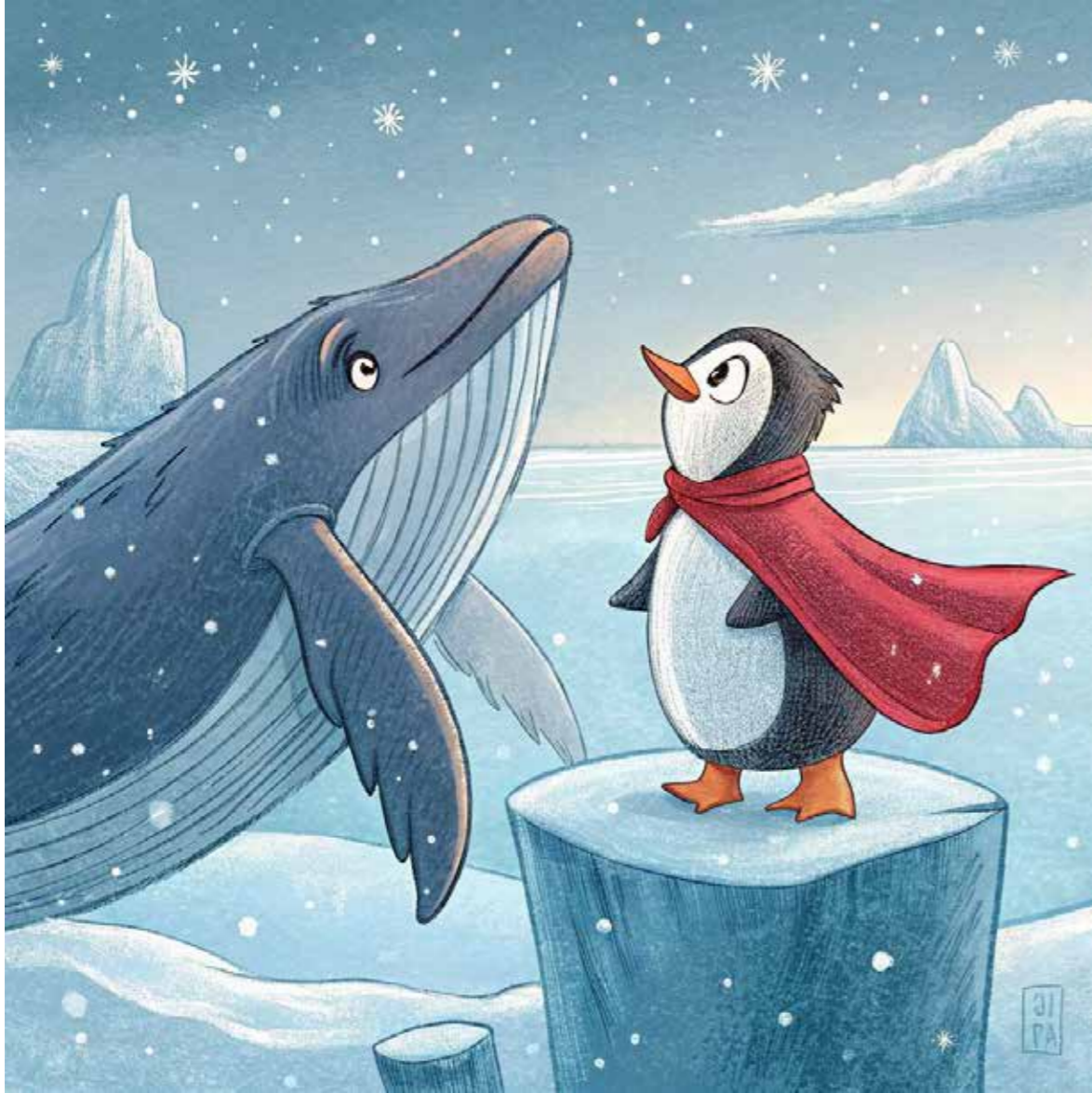
Bella pulled out all the trees and put them in a big pile.

“Hello” said the humpback whale, “my name is Peach”. “Hello and thank you” said Bella and Peggy.

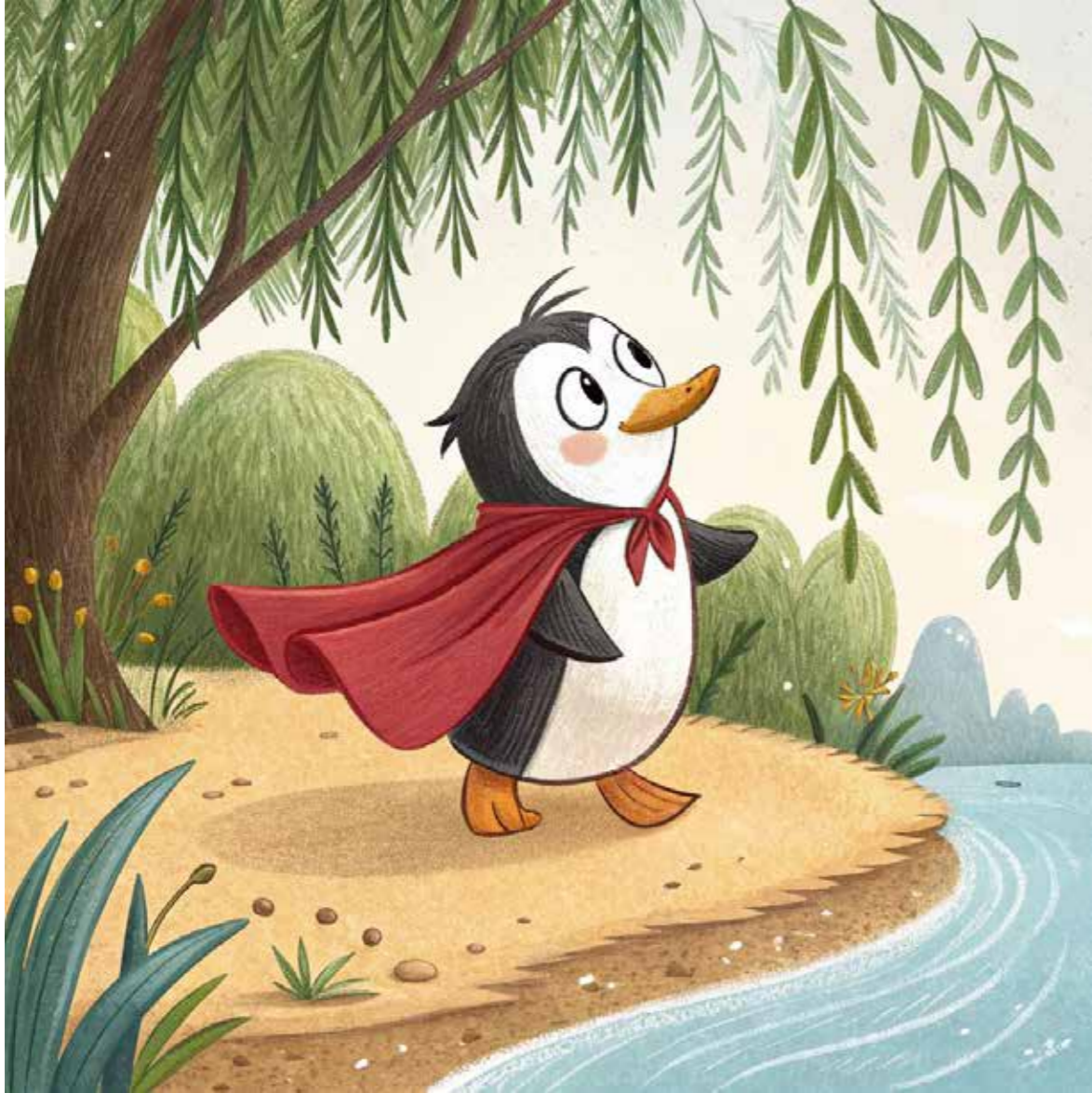
“Can you help us get to an island near us” said Peggy. “Of course” said Peach “I love carrying animals around the world”.
