ever!”**



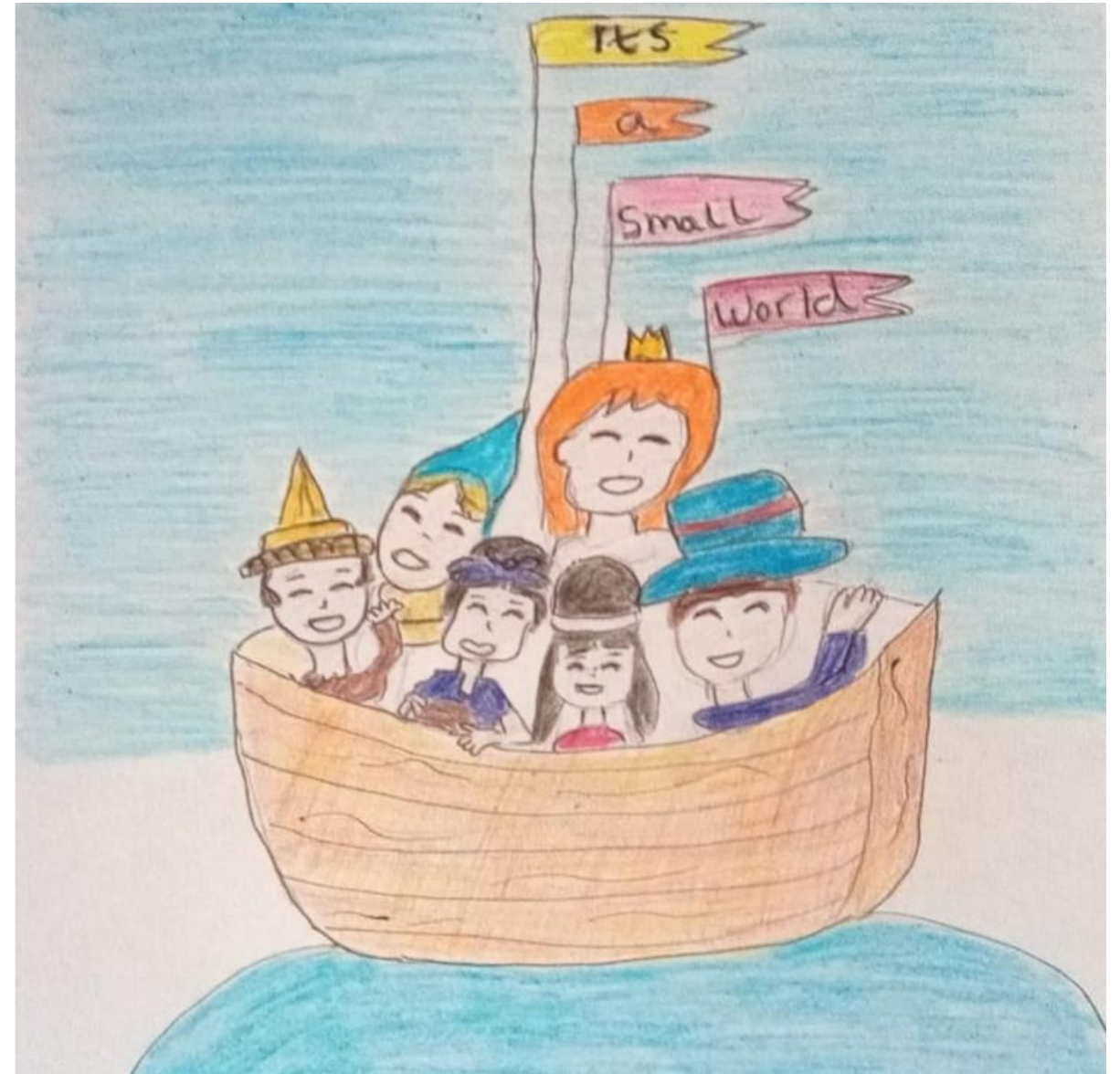
