she felt a chilled

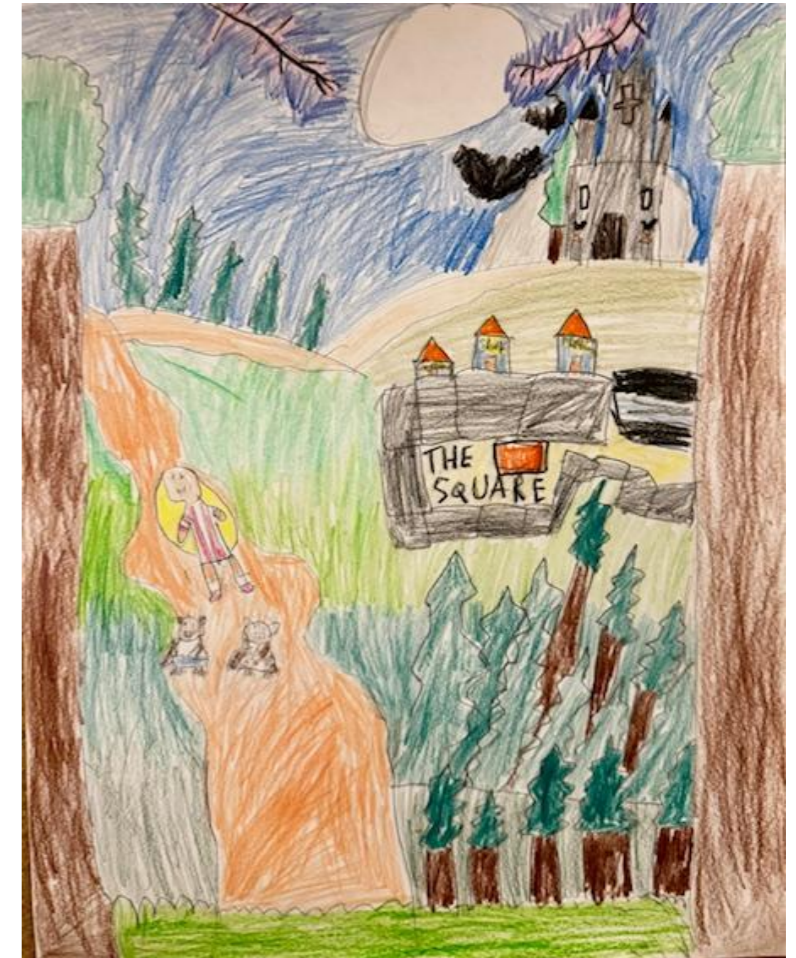
sensation creep up her
